

Common Division Rules

Targets

- ~~E. A clear and unobstructed view of the hit-zone must be afforded from at least one shooting position, however hit-zones should be visible from all shooting positions as far as is reasonably possible.~~
- E. A clear and unobstructed view of the hit-zone must be afforded from at least one shooting position; however, all competitors must have the same opportunity to shoot the target from the same shooting position.
- F. Any obstruction (grass, tree limb, etc.) shall be related to the Chief Marshal and removed prior to the first competitor shooting a lane. If an obstruction occurs by some natural condition during the match and only affects a limited number of shooters, the Match Director, at his/her discretion may remove the obstruction and allow the affected shooters reshoot the target. Otherwise, the obstruction must remain for the duration of the competition unless it creates a hazardous condition, such as a potential for ricochet.
- ~~G. Based on the Troyer Difficulty Rating scale, the average course difficulty shall be no more than 40T, and no individual target difficulty shall be more than 60T.~~
- G. Based on the [Troyer Difficulty Rating System](#), and accounting for all difficulty factors except for light and wind conditions, individual target difficulty shall be no more than 50T and average course difficulty shall be no more than 36T.

Protest Procedure

- A. Any protest must be made to the Match Director no later than 30 minutes after the end of each competition day.
- B. Any protest not made in the same day of the competition will not be considered.
- C. The protest will be analyzed/decided and the answer will be given on the same day.
- D. The Match Director's decision will be final.

Equipment

- G. The Digital Side Wheel (DSW) device is not allowed.

Pistol Field Target Rules

- 14. Forced Offhand Shots: Pistol is held solely by the hands, and may not contact the arms, body, or any other kind of support. Eye-cup contact with the face is permitted.

Match reports

- ~~A. Troyer calculations must include all applicable difficulty factors (including wind and light conditions), to ensure targets are not over 60T and the course not over 40T.~~
- A. Submitted Troyer calculations must include all applicable difficulty factors, including light and wind conditions.
