

2013 AAFTA Nationals Match Report

Despite atypical rainy conditions (for Texas), the 2013 AAFTA U.S. National Championships were a most memorable and hotly-contested affair. With numerous state, national and world champions in attendance, shooters and contingents from such exotic locales as Puerto Rico, Venezuela, Great Britain and *California*, and the presence of the American Airgunner TV crew, the 2013 Nats lived up to expectations in spite of messy conditions and cancellation of the day-two rifle match. Thankfully the day-one rifle match and the pistol FT program went off reasonably well, given the uncomfortable-but-tolerable conditions of light drizzle and muggy humidity. The impressive assemblage of field-target talent unanimously declared the 35 Troyer courses plenty “challenging”.

Testament to the spirit and camaraderie of the close-knit FT community, attendees seemed relatively unfazed by the tribulations Mother Nature threw at them. In fact the difficult conditions added an extra element to “the human drama of athletic competition”, seemingly to the delight of the television crew recording the proceedings for the upcoming season of American Airgunner television. Apparently the combination of Sunday’s PHENOMENAL shrimp and sausage gumbo, door-prizes, airgun and accessory auction, and television coverage helped minimize the competitors’ disappointment over the loss of the second day’s competition. The shooters accepted the disappointment in good cheer and made the most of the other attractions and camaraderie.

In keeping with what sometimes seems a recent trend, WFTF Division shooter Greg Suave recorded the highest score in the rifle match to claim the National Champion title overall and in WFTF. Greg’s awesome score of 58/60 was two points better than Harold Rushton’s second place and Ray Apelles’ third in WFTF, decided by shoot-off.

David Alsup successfully defended his Open PCP National Champion title by posting an excellent 57/60, nipping second place Jim Whittlesey by one point. Mike Vredenburg prevailed in a three-way shoot-off for third, with Warren Williamson taking fourth place and Doug Miller fifth; the three having posted scores of 54/60.

Reigning 2012 Hunter Piston National Champion Scott Hull made a successful transition this year to claim the 2013 Open Hunter National Champion title with an impressive score of 55/60. Defending Hunter Division National Champ Dan Jones claimed second place with an excellent 51/60. Sean Holbeche prevailed in a shoot-off to capture the third place trophy over Doug Witkowski, and Ron Robinson claimed the fifth place trophy in a shoot-off against past Hunter Division National Champion Bill Day.

Kevin Yee blew away the Piston Division to capture the National Champion title with an incredible score of 50/60. Awesome shooting, Kevin!

Manuel Morales of Team Puerto Rico captured the WFTF Piston National Championship with a fine score of 45/60. 2009 Piston National Champion and 2009 AAFTA Grand Prix Champion Leo Duran snatched second place from Matt Brackett in a shoot-off, both of whom recorded excellent scores of 44/60.

Dottie Berry claimed the High Woman title with an excellent score of 54/60. Mike Vredenburg's 54/60 got him the High Senior title and third-place in Open PCP, yet he still wasn't done! Morgan Myers claimed the High Junior FT title to add to her silhouette National Champion title.

Five four-man teams contested the Team competition. Team Tejanos Malos (A.K.A. - David Alsup, Johnny Ingram, Mike Vredenburg and Ron Robinson) captured the High Team trophies with an aggregate score of 207/240. See score-board results for more details of the team competition.

Besides wet, drizzly weather conditions, the pistol field target competition featured possibly the highest Troyer difficulties of any pistol FT match to date. Troyer factors for the pistol targets averaged 19+; translated to more familiar rifle Troyers with a 2X multiplier, a little math sheds more light on the subject. Ron Robinson successfully defended his Hunter Pistol National Champion title with a high pistol score of 45/48, having cleaned every freestyle shot but missed three of the six offhand shots. Bob Dye's fine 42/48 score nabbed him a second-place Hunter Pistol FT trophy to add to a ten-meter pistol State Champion trophy (or two) in his trophy case. Bill Day nipped Sean Holbeche in the shoot-off to decide third and fourth place Hunter Pistol, both with scores of 40/48.

Riz Marquez captured the Open Pistol National Champion trophy by posting a fine score of 38/48 on the challenging course in difficult conditions. Mike Vredenburg added a second-place Open Pistol trophy to his 2013 Nats take of FOUR trophies by relegating Sam Ramirez to third place in the shoot-off. Mike and Sam both posted scores of 35/48.

The reigning National Champ (and pistol-program Match Director) chickened-out of defending his Hands Supported Only pistol title, reduced to quivering fits at the mere mention of the prospect of doing so on such a brutal pistol course (as he'd designed). Not having the option of defending more than one title, the spineless "Champ" made the "easy" choice of defending the Hunter Pistol title instead of Hands Supported. However, past airgun bench-rest World Champion Dan Brown wasn't scared, manning up to post an impressive score of 24/48 to capture the Hands Supported Only National Champion title... on a course never intended for offhand pistol shooting!

To say 2013 Nats was an interesting week-end would be a major under-statement. Thankfully the good nature, character and camaraderie of field target competitors prevailed over the disappointment of an abbreviated rifle match, to make for a "uniquely memorable" experience for all.

To paraphrase... a bunch'a grown "adults" never had such great fun playing with BB guns in a giant mud-hole!
