

2014 Republic of Texas (ROT) AAFTA Regional & Grand Prix Hosted by the Yegua Airgun Club in Somerville, Texas March 7, 8 & 9 2014

Dates/Times- Friday, March 7- 10 AM til sunset, Sight-in range open for practice

Saturday, March 8- 9:30 AM Rifle Match #1, 2:30 PM Pistol FT match

Sunday, March 9- 8:30 AM Rifle Match #2

Mandatory shooters meetings will be held 30 minutes prior to each match

Location- Yegua Airgun Club near Somerville, Texas

Rules- AAFTA rules will be enforced for all ROT Championship matches. It is the shooter's responsibility to adhere to AAFTA rules and **shooters' meeting instructions** concerning SAFETY, equipment, shooting positions, power limits, courses of fire, etiquette, etc. Ignorance of AAFTA rules **or shooters' meeting instructions** is not a valid excuse at the ROT Championship.

The AAFTA rule-book is available at www.AAFTA.org, and the shooters' meeting will be of ample volume for all to hear. The Match Director(s) have final say in any dispute.

Practice/sight-in range- The sight-in range will be open for practice Friday from 10 AM til dark, Saturday & Sunday 7:30 AM until the shooters meetings, and after Saturday's rifle match til dark.

SAFE GUN HANDLING will be strictly enforced at all times!

Courses of fire- The rifle championship will consist of a 60 shot match on Saturday and a 40 shot match on Sunday, for a championship aggregate of 100 shots. The pistol match will be 48 shots.

All lanes will be shot near to far.

Per AAFTA rules, any targets shot out of sequence must be scored as misses.

Divisions/classes- Rifle FT divisions will be Open, Hunter and WFTF. The Match Director may add Piston and PCP classes, or consolidate divisions or classes as needed. A minimum of 3 shooters is required per class or division.

Per current AAFTA rules, pistol FT classes will be Open, Hunter and Hands Supported Only. Pistol competitors may contest two classes, provided they use the same pistol for both classes. If so, the shooter shoots through the pistol course only once, squadded as two shooters in one squad.

Awards- All divisions and classes require a minimum of 3 entrants. Number of entrants determines number of awards, up to 3 places per division/class.

Registration fees- The entry fee of \$85 includes the rifle and pistol matches and lunches on Saturday and Sunday.

Registration forms postmarked before February 1, 2014 will be \$75.

Air- Community air tanks will be available at the sight-in range and on the courses every match.

Meals & Beverages- Lunch will be provided Saturday & Sunday to paid competitors. Guest meals are \$10/ea. Beverages are provided with meals. Drinking water will be on the ranges each match. No shooting or weapons handling after consumption of alcoholic beverages, please.
